MINUTES OF MEETING

Subject:-Minutes of the Screening Committee to examine proposal for financial assistance under State Collaboration Initiatives (SCI)

A meeting of the Screening Committee for examining fresh proposals received for financial assistance under State Collaboration Initiatives (SCI) scheme from various States/Districts/UTs was held under the Chairmanship of Shri NBS. Rajput, Joint Secretary on 21.12.2022 at 4:00 PM through video conferencing.

2. At the outset, Chairman of the Screening Committee Sh. NBS Rajput, Joint Secretary welcomed the participants and requested Sh. K Sanjayan, Director (D&D) to initiate the discussion.
