

BACKGROUND

The Hon'ble Prime Minister had mandated the Department of Administrative Reforms & Public Grievances (DARPG) to hold virtual conferences/webinars with District Collectors and other officers. A specific theme/sector may be taken up in each month, which past award winners since the inception of the scheme under that sector are invited to present their experiences.

In his address on Civil Services Day, 2022, the Hon'ble Prime Minister suggested that training institutes should conduct virtual sessions of one to one and half hours with the award winners as the Lead Speakers, to disseminate the best practices.

Accordingly, DARPG conducts National Good Governance Webinars, one webinar a month on different themes, on the last Friday of every month, over the year 2022 - 2024, to highlight and disseminate the best practices and sharing of experiences of the award-winning institution to facilitate replication by other States/Districts.

These Webinars covered the PM award winning initiatives on the themes 'Improving Public Service Delivery'; 'Health'; 'Aspirational District Programme'; 'Public Grievance Redressal'; 'Environment', 'Public Participation (Jan Bhagidari) through Swachh Bharat Mission'; 'Innovations at District and Centre levels'; 'Jal/Water Management'; 'Namami Gange'; 'Samagra Shiksha'; and 'Holistic Development of Districts'.

These webinars were attended by about 1000 officials from Ministries/Departments, State Governments and District Collectors. Given the encouraging response, it was decided to continue the initiative of organizing the National Good Governance Webinar Series in the year 2025 - 2026.

In the above backdrop, The Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances (DARPG) continues its commitment towards improving governance by celebrating exemplary practices adopted by districts under the Prime Minister's Awards for Excellence in Public Administration. In this context, the 27th National Good Governance webinar on the theme "Holistic Development of Districts" was organized on May 30th, 2025.

The webinar highlighted success stories from two districts – Rajkot, Gujarat and Gomati, Tripura, which have emerged as models in implementing flagship schemes through innovative governance and convergence of efforts.

WELCOME ADDRESS

The session was chaired by **Shri V. Srinivas, Secretary, Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances (DARPG)**, who set the stage by outlining the saturation approach adopted under the Prime Minister’s Awards for Excellence in Public Administration framework.

Smt. Jaya Dubey, Joint Secretary, DARPG, commenced the session by introducing the panel and speakers, and laid the foundation for an enriching webinar. She appreciated the dedication and transformative efforts of the District Magistrates and their teams, which formed the core of the session’s deliberations. She also announced the keynote speakers: **Shri Prabhav Joshi, IAS, District Magistrate & Collector, Rajkot** and **Ms. Rimita Saha, Assistant Collector, Gomati** who represented **Shri Tarit Kanti Chakma, IAS, District Magistrate & Collector, Gomati**, who could not attend due to an unforeseen emergency.

To contextualize the discussions, the session opened with the screening of two short films showcasing impactful implementation of government schemes in the districts of Rajkot and Gomati. These films featured beneficiary testimonials and highlighted how convergence and community participation had led to visible developmental outcomes in sectors such as housing, health, nutrition, water supply, renewable energy, and livelihoods.

The presentations from Rajkot and Gomati were selected to reflect two diverse administrative contexts—a large urban-industrial district and a remote, tribal-dominated hilly region, respectively. Despite their differences, both case studies demonstrated common success factors such as innovation, integration, and institutional capacity building as key enablers of improved governance outcomes.

After screening of the two short films, lead speakers were invited to begin their presentations.



SESSION – I

BRIEF OF THE HOLISTIC DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVE OF RAJKOT DISTRICT, GUJARAT

Rajkot is located in the Saurashtra region of Gujarat has been honored with the Prime Minister’s Award for Excellence in Public Administration 2024 recognizing its exceptional performance in the ‘Holistic Development of Districts’ Category. Its geographical dimensions spans in an area of 11,203 sq. km. The district has emerged as a model of integrated and sustainable development, blending urban progress with rural empowerment.

Known for its leadership in renewable energy adoption, financial inclusion, housing innovation and citizen-centric service delivery, Rajkot has shown exemplary performance in implementing 11 key government schemes. It has adopted a technology-driven approach for public service delivery while ensuring inclusivity, transparency and environmental sustainability.

The district has made significant strides in the implementation of flagship schemes under the Holistic Development of Districts category. The District has achieved more than 80 marks in Mission Indradhanush, Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana & Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana Urban. These data points reflect better governance initiatives aimed at improving immunization coverage, providing financial support to women for maternal health and ensuring dignified housing for urban populations.

Inclusive Welfare through Specialized Initiatives - Programs like Balika Panchayat, Khasangabhut Anganwadi and CSR-led Anganwadi upgrades have fostered inclusive growth, particularly for girls and differently-abled children. Focused interventions have targeted underserved communities, leading to measurable progress in health services, social welfare and urban infrastructure development.

IMPACT OF THE INITIATIVE

- Widespread Solar Adoption & Sustainability - Rajkot leads the nation under PMSGMBY with the highest number of rooftop solar installations, achieved 111.14 MW capacity, reduced approx. 1.39 lakh metric tonnes of GHG emissions annually—equivalent to planting 43 lakh trees.

- Empowerment Through PM Vishwakarma & Poshan 2.0 - Over 62,400 artisans registered under PM Vishwakarma and 13 dedicated training centers established, alongside 80 centers under Poshan 2.0, enhancing skills and employability for thousands.
- Robust Financial Security for Farmers - Ranks 2nd in Gujarat in Kisan Credit Card (KCC) distribution with 2.32 lakh beneficiaries, supported by ₹10 lakh accidental insurance and ₹15,000 medical aid per farmer via Rajkot DCCB.
- Strengthening Health Infrastructure under PM-JAY - Over 15.3 lakh beneficiaries have availed PM-JAY benefits with 3.76 lakh claims settled, saving ₹1,165 Cr in out-of pocket expenses. Two SNCUs (Special Newborn Care Units) were also established in SDHs (Sub District Hospitals), benefiting over 1,670 neonates annually.
- Innovation in Housing & Urban Development- Under the Light House Project, 1,144 EWS dwellings were constructed in under 22 months using in-situ tunnel formwork tech. 12 out of 14 PMAY-Urban projects received the IGBC Green Building Certification.
- Street Vendor Empowerment under PM SVANidhi - A total of 32,935 street vendors received micro-loans, boosting self-employment and livelihoods. Additionally, 365 registered vendors under solar schemes are employing 3,000 people.
- Nutrition and Child Welfare through Saksham Anganwadi & POSHAN 2.0 - Nutritious supplements like Bal Rasayan & Chikkis improved the nutritional status of 42% of 1,777 malnourished children. Over 394 Poshan Vatikas and 330 Anganwadis were enriched with local support and CSR funding.
- Technology-Driven Water Management - Adoption of SCADA and Real-Time Bulk Water Audit Systems in Har Ghar Jal enhanced water distribution and monitoring. Tap connections are now delivered within 20 days under the citizen charter.
- Strong Focus on Capacity Building & Transparency - Over 11,000+ people trained across schemes. Regular social audits, centralized grievance redressal and statutory third party audits ensure transparency, efficiency and beneficiary trust.

PROCEEDINGS

District Magistrate & Collector, Rajkot (Gujarat)

Shri Prabhav Joshi began by expressing his gratitude to the senior leadership at DARPG for the opportunity to present Rajkot's governance journey. He opened his presentation with a geographic and demographic overview of the district—located in the Saurashtra region of Gujarat, with an area of 11,203 square kilometers and a population of approximately 46 lakhs. The district comprises 14 blocks, one municipal corporation, and six Nagar Palikas, and is a hub for MSMEs producing diesel engines and auto parts.

He emphasized the inherent challenge of achieving saturation in schemes given the district's large population base. However, Rajkot had not only managed to meet its targets but exceeded them in several cases. In the PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana, the district recorded 120% achievement, while similarly surpassing targets in Mission Indradhanush, PM Vishwakarma, Har Ghar Jal, and others.

He detailed the significant transformation driven by the solar rooftop initiative, wherein 32,000 households were converted into electricity producers. The district facilitated ₹223.5 crore in subsidies and created an ecosystem of 365 empaneled vendors employing over 3,000 workers. Rajkot now holds the distinction of having the highest penetration of solar rooftops in the country—surpassing even metropolitan regions like Surat and Ahmedabad. Notably, 81% of households had become net producers of electricity, receiving payments from discoms, amounting to ₹15.3 crore annually.

The presentation then turned to housing. He showcased a newly developed Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana Urban township, featuring 12 projects certified by the Indian Green Building Council (IGBC). These townships are equipped with Anganwadi centres, rainwater harvesting systems, community halls, and other modern facilities.

In the agricultural sector, Rajkot demonstrated remarkable financial outreach under the Kisan Credit Card (KCC) scheme, with 2.32 lakh beneficiaries and financing of ₹5,800 crore, making it Gujarat's second-highest in both coverage and volume. This has translated into improved crop yields in wheat, gram, groundnut, and cotton.

The district also achieved high-impact health outcomes. Under Ayushman Bharat-PMJAY, 15.3 lakh beneficiaries were enrolled, and 3.76 lakh claims were settled,

amounting to ₹1165 crore in treatment costs. Rajkot reached 100% saturation in Mission Indra Dhanush, focusing particularly on migrant labourers.

He further elaborated on Rajkot's innovative initiatives, including the Redevelopment of the Arvind Maniyar Housing Society—the first of its kind in Gujarat under the PMAY Urban scheme, creating additional housing stock and offering larger dwellings to current occupants at no extra cost. The project ensured temporary rental housing to beneficiaries during construction, funded by the civic body.

He also highlighted quality assurance measures such as dual inspections by DISCOM engineers in solar schemes, regular bacteriological testing under Har Ghar Jal, and audits through external agencies. A third-party study conducted by the All India Institute of Local Self Government showed 96% of Swanidhi beneficiaries felt more financially secure, and 72% reported improved housing conditions.

Rajkot has institutionalized grievance redressal through command-and-control centres, mobile applications, and the Swagat Programme, wherein citizens can directly address issues in presence of senior officials. Transparency is further promoted through social audits and public participation via Pani Samitis and Arogya Samitis.

The district also leveraged the Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra by organizing 636 outreach camps, exposure visits, and awareness rallies. Behavioural studies by the University of Baroda indicated that 99% of solar panel beneficiaries proactively cleaned their panels to ensure efficiency. Many beneficiaries reinvested savings into household upgrades, with 43% purchasing air conditioners and 14% buying electric vehicles.

The presentation emphasized capacity-building efforts, where 11,215 participants were trained under Poshan 2.0, and convergence was enabled through profiling of 54,000 street vendor families, providing them additional schemes like PM Suraksha Bima Yojana and PM Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana.

Rajkot's use of technology—ranging from real-time SCADA systems, QR codes, and mobile tracking apps—enabled efficient service delivery and monitoring. Under the Lighthouse Project, the district constructed 1,144 dwellings using tunnel formwork technology in record time, a feat recognized by the Hon'ble Prime Minister in the Mann Ki Baat programme.

He concluded with a powerful case study of Shivu Bha, a Divyang beneficiary from Dayya village, who benefited from multiple schemes, including surplus solar electricity income and a motorized tricycle. The session ended with reaffirmation of Rajkot's commitment to social justice through the saturation approach and acknowledgement of the Prime Minister's vision.












PRODUCTIVITY ENHANCEMENT THROUGH KCC



Wheat Productivity in Rajkot






Declining trend of Measles Cases due to increase in Immunization coverage




QUALITY CONTROL: AUDITS AND IMPACT ASSESSMENT

- In Solar rooftop scheme, every installation is checked by DISCOM engineer **twice**.
- Under Har Ghar Jal, **3,200 bacteriological** testing kits have been deployed in **599** villages and schools under water quality programme. Through which a total of **7,762** water samples were tested.

DISTRICT INITIATIVES: PMJAY

- Funds from the PM-JAY were used to establish two **10-bedded Special Newborn Care Units (SNCUs)** at Sub-District Hospitals (SDH) in Gondal and Upleta.
- Benefiting more than **835 neonates** per facility in last 1 year, saving life of many of the neonates.
- This initiative was widely appreciated by **AIIMS, Rajkot** in their impact assessment study.



DISTRICT INITIATIVES : POSHAN 2.0

- Ayurvedic Bal Rasayan, Chikkis (made from jaggery, ground nuts) were given to **1,777** malnourished children through Jilla Panchayat funds, raising nutritional status of **42%** of them.
- **330** Anganwadis were provided wooden toys set from DMF fund which were manufactured by Self-Help Groups under NRLM.



DISTRICT INITIATIVES: POSHAN 2.0

- Total **394 Poshan Vatikas** have been developed.
- Rajkot Municipal Corporation(RMC) has provided **Water Cooler** in **211** Anganwadis.



DISTRICT INITIATIVES :POSHAN 2.0

- As part of CSR, **Amul** dairy is delivering **milk** directly to Anganwadi centers catering **886 Malnourished** Children daily.
- Rotary Club provided **Protein** powder.



SOCIAL INCLUSION

- **Incentive** amount of Rs 3 lakhs given to **6 water committees** having 70% or more **women** members in Har Ghar Jal Scheme.
- Under Rajkot District, total **262** BPL consumers have taken benefit of **PMSG-MBY** scheme by installing **Solar Rooftop** of 405 KW. Out of them **121** consumers are presently getting Zero bill, additionally **99** Nos. of consumers are reimbursed about **Rs. 870/- per month** against the surplus solar power injected in to the Grid in the Month of December 2024.



REPLICABILITY & SUSTAINABILITY

- The incentive of ₹ given to the doctors and staffs provided through the **PM-JAY** has led to a significant enhancement in doctor's recruitment in areas that previously faced challenges in attracting qualified personnel.
- As per the available data, on an average 1 MW solar power plant can reduce around **1,250** Metric tones of GHGs emissions every year. By installing 111.14 MW **Solar Rooftop**, Rajkot has contributed towards reducing approximately **1,39,000** Metric tones of GHGs annually, which equivalent to planting approx. **43 lakh trees**.






Pvt hosp inflates bill, tampers with reports

Rajkot: A paediatric hospital in Rajkot has been fined Rs 6.54 crore for committing irregularities under the Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PMJAY) scheme in case of 116 patients. The hospital, Nihit Baby care, had tampered with medical reports and submitted inflated bills to the health department for approval.

An investigation conducted by the health department over 45 days uncovered the irregularities conducted by Dr Hiren Mashru, who runs the hospital on Laxmi Nagar Main Road. According to the district health authority, the modified reports for 116 patients had been sent for approval with a total claim amount of Rs 65.47 lakh.



BRIEF OF THE HOLISTIC DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVE OF GOMATI DISTRICT, TRIPURA

Gomati district, located in Tripura, is emerging as a model of balanced development— blending cultural heritage with modern governance. The region spans in an area of approx 1523 square km. The district has been honored with the Prime Minister’s Award for Excellence in Public Administration 2024 recognizing its exceptional performance in the ‘Holistic Development of Districts’ Category. It showcased excellence across 11 government schemes through robust social audit mechanisms, quality control processes and community engagement initiatives.

The district implemented effective capacity-building programs, empowered citizens through Jan Bhagidari and encouraged behavioral change towards sanitation, gender sensitization and environmental conservation. The district is actively promoting local identity through GI-tagged products like Matabari Peda and traditional crafts like Risha and Pachra, supporting artisans and boosting the rural economy. Governance initiatives such as the Tripura CM Helpline (1905) and extensive field visits by the District Magistrate have strengthened transparency and public engagement.

The district has shown remarkable progress in implementing flagship schemes under the Holistic Development of Districts category. The District has achieved more than 80 marks in major schemes including Mission Indradhanush, Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana & Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana Urban, showcasing strong governance efforts.

These accomplishments highlight focused initiatives to improve immunization rates, provide financial support for maternal health and promote dignified urban housing. Moreover, the promotion of traditional products such as Matabari Peda, Risha and Pachra reflects the district’s emphasis on cultural preservation, tourism, and sustainable livelihood generation. Gomati’s Focused efforts in underserved areas have resulted in significant progress in health services, social welfare and urban infrastructure.

IMPACT OF THE INITIATIVE

- Skill Development Under PM Vishwakarma & SANKALP - 7,086 beneficiaries enrolled; 2,239 completed pre-basic and 2,219 completed basic training under

PM Vishwakarma, while 150 candidates finished entrepreneurship trained under SANKALP Phase-II initiative of the district, fostering self-employment and skilled workforce.

- Employment through Capacity Building Initiatives - Youths were trained in key sectors: 100 as Plumber Generals, 42 in Geriatric Care and 28 as Jal Vitaran Sanchalak, directly boosting employability and infrastructure development at the grassroots.
- Green Drive for Environmental Sustainability- A remarkable 7 lakh saplings were planted in 2024, including 1.2 lakh in just 5 minutes on World Environment Day, reinforcing the district's commitment to afforestation and climate action.
- Gender Equality and Social Awareness - Gender sensitization workshops were conducted, encouraging community-level awareness, reducing discrimination and promoting social equity and inclusion.
- Transparency via Technology - The Tripura CM Helpline (1905) has strengthened governance transparency, enabling anonymous corruption reporting, with 51 cases resolved via CPGRAMS and 19 through the CM helpline.
- Field Visits and Grassroots Engagement -The District Magistrate conducted 852 field visits, including 780 inspections and 72 community programs, ensuring accountability, feedback collection and citizen-centric administration.
- Promotion of Local Handicrafts and GI-Tagged Products - With district-level intervention, Matabari Peda was granted a GI tag, while local handicrafts like Risha and art forms like Pachra were promoted, uplifting artisans and bolstering the regional economy.
- Outreach via Viksit Bharat Yatra - 16 camps were organized under the Viksit Bharat Yatra, enhancing awareness, delivery and saturation of welfare schemes to underserved sections of the population.

PROCEEDINGS

Following the Rajkot presentation, the session was handed over to **Ms. Rimita Saha**, Assistant Collector, Gomati. She was introduced by **Shri V. Srinivas, Secretary, DARPG**, as the youngest officer to present at the National Good Governance Webinar, setting an inspiring tone for the upcoming insights from one of India's most remote and challenging districts.

Ms. Rimita Saha began by extending greetings to the dignitaries and participants. She provided a comprehensive overview of Gomati district, located in the northeastern state of Tripura, covering a geographical area of 1,520 square kilometers. The district comprises three subdivisions and eight blocks, with a total population of 5.12 lakh, of which approximately 1.8 lakh belong to Scheduled Tribes—making tribal representation a significant element in the district's governance.

She began by highlighting the cultural richness and spiritual heritage of the region, referencing prominent landmarks such as the Tripureshwari Temple, one of the 51 sacred Shakti Peeths, which serves as a spiritual and cultural anchor for the community.

Transitioning to the schemes under the Prime Minister's Awards for Excellence in Public Administration, she elaborated on Gomati's performance across all 11 flagship schemes, starting with Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PMJAY). The district has achieved 80% saturation, extending health coverage to approximately 2.15 lakh individuals, with targeted efforts underway to bridge the remaining gap.

In Saksham Anganwadi and Poshan 2.0, the district recorded 96.93% coverage, ensuring essential nutrition to children and mothers. A similar level of success was reported under Mission Indra Dhanush, with vaccination drives reaching 96% saturation across women and children, even in remote tribal hamlets.

Under the Jal Jeevan Mission, the district achieved 84.19% household tap water connections, covering approximately 90,000 households. Given the hilly and forested terrain, this milestone required intensive logistical planning and coordination with village water and sanitation committees.

For the PM Swanidhi Yojana, despite having only two urban local bodies, the district sanctioned loans to 833 street vendors, achieving 81.6% saturation, reflecting an effective microfinance outreach model even in smaller municipalities.

In terms of housing, Gomati attained 97.60% saturation under PM Awas Yojana Gramin, with coverage extended to tribal families in remote forested areas. The PMAY

Urban also showed commendable progress, reaching 79.96% saturation, providing secure shelter and basic amenities to nearly 4,000 households.

Under the PM Matru Vandana Yojana, financial and nutritional support was provided to expectant and lactating mothers, with 95.2% saturation. The Kisan Credit Card scheme was another area of emphasis, given the agrarian nature of the district. More than 28,700 households were covered, ensuring timely access to credit for farm inputs and seasonal livelihood support.

The PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana, although newly introduced in the district, had already benefitted 10 households, with 210 additional applications in the pipeline, targeted for implementation in the coming month. Similarly, the PM Vishwakarma Yojana extended its reach to over 4,600 artisans and craftsmen, many of whom belong to tribal communities that rely on traditional skills for livelihood.

She then detailed the unique challenges the district faced in implementing these schemes. These included:

- Frequent and devastating floods during the extended monsoon season, affecting up to 1.25 lakh people and temporarily disrupting scheme implementation.
- Difficult terrain, which made access to interior habitations logistically challenging.
- Cultural and linguistic diversity, with 19 tribal communities, each with distinct customs, presenting coordination challenges for outreach.
- Shortage of skilled personnel, such as trained masons, which resulted in construction bottlenecks under housing schemes.
- Dispersed population density, making community mobilization and Jan Bhagidari efforts more difficult.

Despite these hurdles, the district developed a quantitative and qualitative approach. On the quantitative front, the administration ensured data-driven targeting, mobilized elected representatives and Panchayati Raj Institutions, and conducted continuous saturation mapping. On the qualitative front, Gomati introduced feedback mechanisms using QR codes at Panchayat offices, promoting real-time grievance redressal.

She presented several innovative initiatives being undertaken in the district:

- The "Clean and Green Office" campaign, which promoted eco-consciousness across administrative setups. She cited a mega plantation drive where 1.2 lakh saplings were planted within five minutes with active involvement from Gram Panchayats, Anganwadi centres, hospitals, and community institutions.
- Use of Smaran App by government officers to list and track their daily responsibilities, promoting internal efficiency and accountability.

- Solar-powered Panchayats and Anganwadi centres equipped with CCTV surveillance, clean drinking water facilities, and child-friendly infrastructure to address recurring power outages.
- Establishment of Divyang-friendly public offices with accessible infrastructure, including mother-and-child care rooms and baby feeding corners, reflecting inclusivity in design and function.
- Promotion of Model Panchayats and Model Anganwadis, with clear activity calendars launched by the Hon'ble Governor.
- Introduction of digital services at the Panchayat level, including online access to records of rights and service delivery.
- Recognition and motivation of field staff through performance awards, fostering a culture of excellence and service pride.

She also described Gomati's innovative approach to Jal Jeevan Mission implementation in difficult terrains. In some hilly locations, water is sourced from local cheras (streams) and transported through innovative reservoir-based delivery systems to reach households.

Highlighting transparency and institutional oversight, she noted that social audits, AG audits, and internal audits were being conducted periodically. The district also regularly held review meetings and field inspections across block and panchayat levels.

On grievance redressal, the district relied on multi-tiered systems, including CPGRAMS, the CM Helpline, the Amar Sarkar app, and Panchayat-level QR code submissions.

She further concluded her presentation with notable recognitions and success stories:

- In 2023, Gomati district received the Bhumi Samman Award from the Hon'ble President of India for outstanding work in digitization of land records.
- In 2024, Amarpur block received the Panchayat Award.
- In 2025, the district was recognized under the Prime Minister's Excellence Award, showcasing its efforts to align with the Viksit Bharat Vision 2047.

In her closing remarks, she acknowledged the tireless efforts of the field officers, community stakeholders, and the district administration in implementing these schemes under challenging circumstances.



As part of the administrative re-organization effected in October, 2012, Gomati District comprise of Udaipur, Amarpur and Karbook sub-divisions.


The Gomati District is bounded on the North by Dhalai District, West Tripura District and Sipahijala District while on the other sides by international border with Bangladesh.

VOTE OF THANKS

The session concluded with a formal **Vote of Thanks** delivered by **Shri Puneet Yadav**, Additional Secretary, Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances (DARPG). In his closing remarks, he extended his heartfelt appreciation to both the presenters—**Shri Prabhav Joshi**, District Magistrate & Collector, Rajkot and **Ms. Rimita Saha**, Assistant Collector, Gomati district—for their detailed, insightful, and inspiring presentations that truly captured the spirit of the Prime Minister’s Awards for Excellence in Public Administration.

He began by noting the remarkable contrast and complementarity between the two districts—Rajkot representing a highly industrialized urban-rural mixed landscape, and Gomati symbolizing a geographically remote, tribal-dominated terrain. Yet, both, he emphasized, had demonstrated exceptional commitment to good governance, institutional innovation, and delivery of last-mile services, despite the vastly different contexts in which they operate.

He highlighted the transparency and objectivity of this year’s PM Awards evaluation process. He pointed out, this edition relied heavily on ministry-sourced data, independently verified through dashboards, portals, and field visits. This system enabled a level playing field and truly rewarded districts based on actual ground-level implementation and performance.

He lauded the Rajkot district for achieving the highest national score in the PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana. He underscored that Rajkot’s approach—transforming consumers into electricity producers, building an ecosystem of vendors, and ensuring sustainability—was a model of convergence and impact.

Turning to Gomati district, Shri Yadav expressed equal admiration, highlighting that the district’s achievements were commendable given its topographical and infrastructural constraints. He specifically acknowledged the leadership of District Magistrate Tarit Kanti Chakma and commended Ms. Rimita Saha for stepping up to deliver a comprehensive and articulate presentation on short notice. He noted that Gomati’s success demonstrated that innovation, teamwork, and strong administrative will could overcome even the most difficult challenges of geography and resource limitations.

He also took the opportunity to encourage all participating district administrators to take inspiration from the examples presented during the session. He stressed that while all

11 schemes under the PM Awards framework are being implemented nationwide, what distinguishes leading districts is the “soft edge” of governance—including community engagement, digital feedback mechanisms, third-party audits, and inter-departmental convergence. He reiterated that such seemingly small interventions often cumulatively deliver significant, scalable impact.

In his closing words, Shri Yadav extended his gratitude to Secretary DARPG, Shri V. Srinivas, for his vision and leadership in institutionalizing the National Good Governance Webinars as a platform for collaborative learning and knowledge exchange among civil servants.

He expressed appreciation to the teams at DARPG, the district administrations, technical moderators, and all 1300+ officers and stakeholders who joined the session from across the country. He concluded with a note of optimism, stating that India’s journey towards Viksit Bharat 2047 would be accelerated by such determined, innovation-led efforts at the district level.

With these words, the 27th National Good Governance Webinar was formally brought to a close.
