

# BACKGROUND

The Hon'ble Prime Minister had mandated the Department of Administrative Reforms & Public Grievances (DARPG) to hold virtual conferences/webinars with District Collectors and other officers. A specific theme/sector may be taken up in each month, which past award winners since the inception of the scheme under that sector are invited to present their experiences.

In his address on Civil Services Day, 2022, the Hon'ble Prime Minister suggested that training institutes should conduct virtual sessions of one to one and half hours with the award winners as the Lead Speakers, to disseminate the best practices.

Accordingly, DARPG conducts National Good Governance Webinars, one webinar a month on different themes, on the last Friday of every month, over the year 2022 - 2024, to highlight and disseminate the best practices and sharing of experiences of the award-winning institution to facilitate replication by other States/Districts.

These Webinars covered the PM award winning initiatives on the themes 'Improving Public Service Delivery'; 'Health'; 'Aspirational District Programme'; 'Public Grievance Redressal'; 'Environment', 'Public Participation (Jan Bhagidari) through Swachh Bharat Mission'; 'Innovations at District and State levels'; 'Jal/Water Management'; 'Namami Gange'; 'Samagra Shiksha'; and 'Holistic Development of Districts'.

These webinars were attended by about 1000 officials from Ministries/Departments, State Governments and District Collectors. Given the encouraging response, it was decided to continue the initiative of organizing the National Good Governance Webinar Series in the year 2025 - 2026.

In the above backdrop, The Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances (DARPG) continues its commitment towards improving governance by celebrating exemplary practices adopted by districts under the Prime Minister's Awards for Excellence in Public Administration. In this context, the 29th National Good Governance webinar on the theme "Innovation - State" was organized on 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2025.

The webinar highlighted successful initiative from two States – Uttarakhand and Assam, which have emerged as models in innovative governance.

# WELCOME ADDRESS

The session was chaired by **Shri V. Srinivas**, Secretary, Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances (DARPG). In his opening remarks, he outlined the **innovative practices in governance** adopted under the *Prime Minister's Awards for Excellence in Public Administration* framework. He emphasized that the webinar was organized in pursuance of the direction given by the Hon'ble Prime Minister during **Civil Services Day 2022**, where the Prime Minister had suggested that **virtual sessions** be held to allow award winners to share their experiences.

The Secretary noted that a significant number of awardees from various districts and states have already presented their successful initiatives through this platform. He appreciated the **dedication and transformative governance efforts** of the **State Governments of Uttarakhand and Assam**, which were the focal points of the session.

He also introduced the **keynote speakers** for the theme "*Innovation – State*": **Ms. Nitika Khandelwal, IAS**, District Magistrate, Tehri Garhwal, Government of Uttarakhand and **Dr. Om Prakash**, Mission Director, Samagra Shiksha, Government of Assam.

To set the context for the discussion, the session began with the **screening of two short films** highlighting impactful implementation of government schemes in **Uttarakhand and Assam**. These films showcased innovations such as: Use of **AI and satellite imagery** for maintaining digital records of public assets in Uttarakhand and Integration of **digital technology and artificial intelligence in education** in Assam.

Following the screenings, the keynote speakers were invited to present their experiences and insights.



# SESSION – I

## BRIEF OF UTTARAKHAND GOVERNMENT ASSETS MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (UK-GAMS) INITIATIVE

The *Uttarakhand Government Assets Management System (UK-GAMS)* is a state-wide digital innovation developed to safeguard and monitor government land across Uttarakhand. Institutionalized through a government order, UK-GAMS integrates AI/ML-powered change detection using high-resolution satellite imagery with real-time mobile field validation. It offers an end-to-end platform that enables departments to proactively track asset use, prevent encroachments and ensure timely interventions.

With over 66,000 assets mapped and 60+ departments on boarded, the initiative represents a transformative leap toward transparent, data-driven governance. Its unified web-mobile interface ensures seamless collaboration, faster decision-making and reduced manual errors, making it the first state-level geospatial asset protection system to be fully integrated into departmental operations.

### KEY ASPECTS

- Enables real-time detection of unauthorized land-use changes and encroachments.
- Fully digitized workflows replace manual records, promoting efficiency and transparency.
- Build a low-cost, scalable and open-source system that is easily replicable, compatible with existing technologies and integrated with national platforms like PM Gati Shakti to fast-track infrastructure development using validated geospatial data.

### IMPACT OF THE INITIATIVE

- 66,000+ government assets mapped; 52,000+ geofenced across the state.
- ₹14,000 Cr worth of public land monitored; ₹53 Cr worth of encroachments detected.
- ~220 assets mapped per day, with 188 alerts generated for quick redressal.
- Enhanced coordination among 60+ departments, 7 directorates and 25 boards.
- Reduced grievance resolution time from months to weeks via real-time field reporting.
- Improved land governance benefits over 1 crore residents across 53,000+ sq. km of varied terrain.

# PROCEEDINGS

Ms. Nitika Khandelwal began by expressing her gratitude to the senior leadership at DARPG for the opportunity to present the Uttarakhand Government Assets Management System (UK-GAMS). She opened her presentation with the problem of encroachment of Government properties and challenges faced by the state government.

She underscored that encroachment of government properties is a monumental challenge confronting state governments across India, with the Government of Uttarakhand being particularly affected. This issue stems from several key factors, including the absence of a centralized asset inventory that would facilitate streamlined management and oversight of government assets. Moreover, the lack of accurate geofenced data hampers efforts to define and protect government land boundaries. The problem is further compounded by fragmented departmental coordination, where different agencies operate in isolation, leading to gaps in monitoring and enforcement. Additionally, the absence of a consistent data trail for government land creates uncertainty and disputes over ownership and boundaries. Manual and time-consuming processes, coupled with limited transparency and accountability, exacerbate the issue. The challenging terrain in many areas of Uttarakhand also reduces accessibility for physical inspections, making it even more difficult to manage and protect government properties effectively.

To tackle the multifaceted challenges of government asset management, the Uttarakhand Government introduced the Uttarakhand Government Assets Management System (UK-GAMS). This comprehensive system is supported by a robust governance structure, comprising a three-tier committee framework. At the apex level, a State-Level Committee, headed by the Chief Secretary, provides strategic oversight and direction. A State Working Group, led by the Revenue Secretary, functions as a key operational arm, driving the implementation and coordination of UK-GAMS. Additionally, District-Level Committees, each headed by the District Magistrate, ensure effective execution and monitoring of asset management initiatives at the grassroots level. This hierarchical structure facilitates a cohesive and coordinated approach to managing government assets across the state.

The Government of Uttarakhand has developed a web-based geo-portal and mobile application, acquired high-resolution satellite imagery, and designed a role-based mobile application for asset collection and geo-fencing. These applications are provided to all departments for the digitization of their assets. These include developing a web-based geo-portal for centralized asset mapping and monitoring, acquiring high-resolution satellite imagery for precise land use and boundary data, and deploying a role-based mobile application for real-time asset data collection and verification. The mobile application also

includes geo-fencing features for accurate boundary demarcation and enhanced asset security. By integrating these technologies, the government aims to optimize asset management processes, ensure data accuracy.

The web and mobile application boasts an array of features, including role-based access that ensures authorized personnel can view and interact with relevant data. The application provides a comprehensive 26 district base map, offering a granular view of the region. It also includes four types of dashboards that cater to different user needs, along with a Decision Support System (DSS) and Management Information System (MIS) reports that facilitate informed decision-making. Additional features include overlay capabilities that enable users to visualize multiple data layers, a query builder that allows for customized data extraction, polygon creation for precise area demarcation, and measurement tools that provide accurate spatial analysis. These features collectively enhance the application's functionality, making it an indispensable tool for asset management and spatial planning.

The working of the model involves a multi-step process that begins with data provided by the user, which is then utilized to create labels based on visual identification of built-up areas. These labels are subsequently modified or new ones are created based on the output of the results. A rigorous quality assurance and quality control process is then implemented to validate the output, ensuring accuracy and reliability. This process is supported by high-resolution satellite imagery and a trained artificial intelligence/machine learning model that enables efficient and precise asset identification and mapping.


The digitization of properties enables accurate detection of unauthorized land-use changes, allowing for prompt action to prevent encroachment and protect government assets. This approach is significantly faster and more effective than traditional manual methods. By digitizing properties, authorities can respond swiftly to potential threats, ensuring the integrity of land records and minimizing the likelihood of disputes or litigation. This proactive approach to land management helps to safeguard public assets and promote more efficient use of resources.

The digitization of government properties provides numerous benefits, including furnishing departments with vital information on available government parcels around key hill railway stations thereby enabling the government to plan and develop future infrastructure projects, commercial facilities and other essential amenities in a more informed and strategic manner.

Exploring potential use cases, the system leverages pre-processing of satellite or drone imagery which requires a foundational base data of land boundary layers. High-resolution imagery is then utilized to train an AI model which is run on before-and-after imagery to detect changes. Post-processing analysis identifies areas of suspected encroachments triggering field verification initiatives. The status of encroachment is then updated on a dashboard.

Also a potential case involves providing a baseline or proposed project plan with geo-fencing and a map layer of the project as per the Request for Proposal (RFP), defining important milestones with expected changes that can be visualized through imagery upon achieving each milestone. As progress is tracked, automated pre-defined alerts are generated when a milestone is achieved ensuring stakeholders are informed and up-to-date on project developments.

In conclusion, she highlighted that for the protection of government properties from encroachment the Uttarakhand government introduced the Uttarakhand Government Assets Management System (UK-GAMS). As of now, 66,000 assets have been mapped and 52,000 polygons have been created. Directions have been given to all departments to review their assets and the Government of Uttarakhand collects data quarterly from high-priority areas and collect data every six months from low-priority areas.



# SESSION – II

## BRIEF OF THE SHIKSHA SETU, AXOM, ASSAM

SHIKSHA SETU, AXOM is an AI-driven initiative implemented through Samagra Shiksha Assam, Department of School Education. It leverages advanced facial recognition technology that maps over 70 facial feature points to ensure accurate, geo-tagged attendance of both students and teachers, effectively eliminating proxy attendance and ghost students. With statewide implementation, this initiative ensures transparent, efficient and responsive education governance.

It also facilitates digital teacher leave management, seamless student transfers without the need for transfer certificates, predictive analytics for dropout prevention and resource planning. Designed to function even in low-connectivity or disaster-affected areas via cloud and offline sync features, Shiksha Setu, Axom is setting a new benchmark for real-time, data-driven decision-making and inclusive service delivery in the public education sector.

### KEY ASPECTS

- Automated digital DropBox system allows student transfers without transfer certificates.
- Online leave application and approval system for teachers, replacing manual processes.
- Predictive analytics help identify likely dropouts and support resource planning.
- Over 2.07 lakh teachers and officials trained; 51,000+ tablets distributed to schools.
- Active engagement with teachers, school committees and parent bodies for smooth adoption.

### IMPACT OF THE INITIATIVE

- Impacted over 48 lakh students and 2.06 lakh teachers and tracked across 44,866 government and aided schools in Assam.
- Removal of 4 lakh ghost students leads to savings of Rs 100 Cr/year to the Government.
- 67% of head teachers report improved teacher attendance (UNICEF Study).
- Enhanced trust among teachers and school management through effective grievance redressal.
- Received the National Awards for e-Governance 2024 (Gold).

# PROCEEDINGS

Following the Uttarakhand presentation, the session was handed over to **Dr. Om Prakash**, Mission Director, Samagra Shiksha, Assam. He was introduced by **Shri V. Srinivas**, Secretary, DARPG.

Dr. Om Prakash began by expressing his gratitude to the senior leadership at DARPG for the opportunity to present Shiksha Setu, the initiative of the Government of Assam.

Shiksha Setu Assam is a pioneering initiative of the Government of Assam aimed at addressing key service delivery gaps in the education sector related to school administration, teacher management and student monitoring.

He emphasized that Shiksha Setu covers over 44,866 schools, more than 2,06,402 teachers and approximately 48.4 million students and parents. Prior to this initiative, there was an absence of digital registries for teachers, students and schools with irregular teacher transfers occurring regardless of pupil-teacher ratio (PTR), non-availability of subject-wise teachers, inadequate infrastructure, ghost enrollments of students, proxy teachers, unauthorized absenteeism and lack of real-time data for effective planning. Additionally, student transfer processes were time-consuming and difficult and there were delays in leave approvals with teachers sometimes involved in non-academic activities.

To overcome these issues, Shiksha Setu incorporates AI-powered facial recognition technology to capture attendance in real time, down to hours, minutes and seconds, both individually and in groups, with offline functionality to allow usage even without internet connectivity. More than 5 million students and teachers register their daily attendance through the platform. This robust system eliminates proxy attendance and unauthorized absenteeism, resulting in teachers not only coming to schools but arriving on time, with a UNICEF study indicating that 67% of head teachers have reported improved teacher attendance. For students, about 3 lakh ghost or duplicate enrollments have been removed and the system enables close monitoring of those absent for one or more weeks. Using predictive analytics the platform identifies students at risk of dropping out and facilitates efforts to bring them back to school. These improvements have also helped the government save approximately Rs. 100 crores annually on the distribution of free textbooks, uniforms and mid-day meal schemes.

The platform extends this digital transformation by rationalizing teacher deployment through evaluating the needs of the School based on Pupil Teacher Ratio and using criteria such as proximity, age, qualifications and gender to determine transfers. Teachers' utilization status is analyzed, distinguishing between over, under and adequately utilized staff, while retirement

trends are monitored to support timely recruitment processes. The system also proposes school amalgamations by identifying nearby schools suitable for merging based on infrastructure, distance and teacher availability.

Further benefits include the automation of student transfers through a "student dropbox" feature allowing students to enroll in any government or provincialized school within Assam without the need for transfer certificates, simplifying mobility across the state. Digital leave management enables teachers to apply and receive leave approvals online efficiently, with various leave types sanctioned in bulk, including casual, maternity, child care and extraordinary leaves. Shiksha Setu maintains comprehensive digital registries for teachers, schools and students, capturing personal details, qualifications, bank accounts, school infrastructure, enrolment, parental information, social categories and health data which are instrumental for effective monitoring and evidence-based decision-making.

The implementation has encountered challenges like resistance from teachers to use new digital technologies, lack of technical knowledge, occasional glitches and network issues in remote areas. Addressing these challenges has involved training efforts and continuous technological support. The initiative also focuses on business process re-engineering incorporating AI attendance tracking, leave management, predictive workforce optimization analytics, seamless student and teacher transfers, online service book management and SMS alerts to parents about student absences beyond one week.

Overall, Shiksha Setu Axom demonstrates a successful example of leveraging digital technology and AI to improve educational governance, optimize resource allocation, enhance accountability and save public expenditure while fostering transparency and timely data-driven decision-making across Assam's schooling system.


