- Mrs. Aarti Rana (Tharu Woman) honored in New Delhi



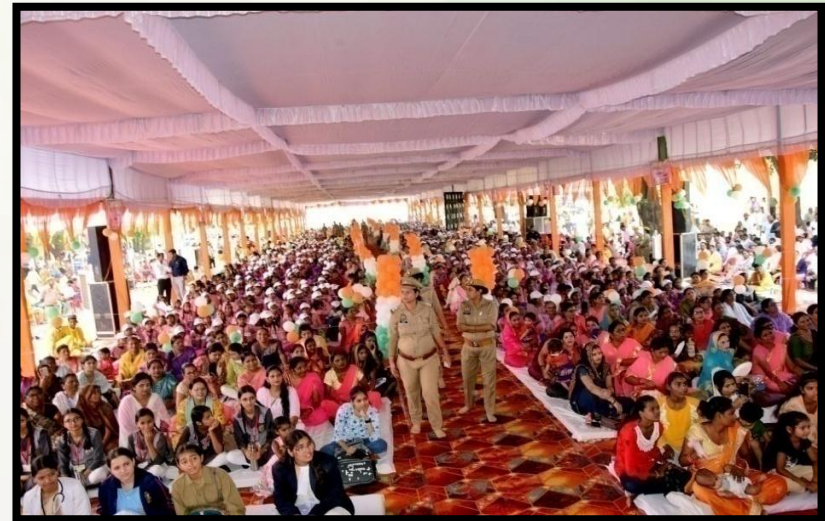
Mission Shakti For Women

- Promote inclusive grassroots decision-making

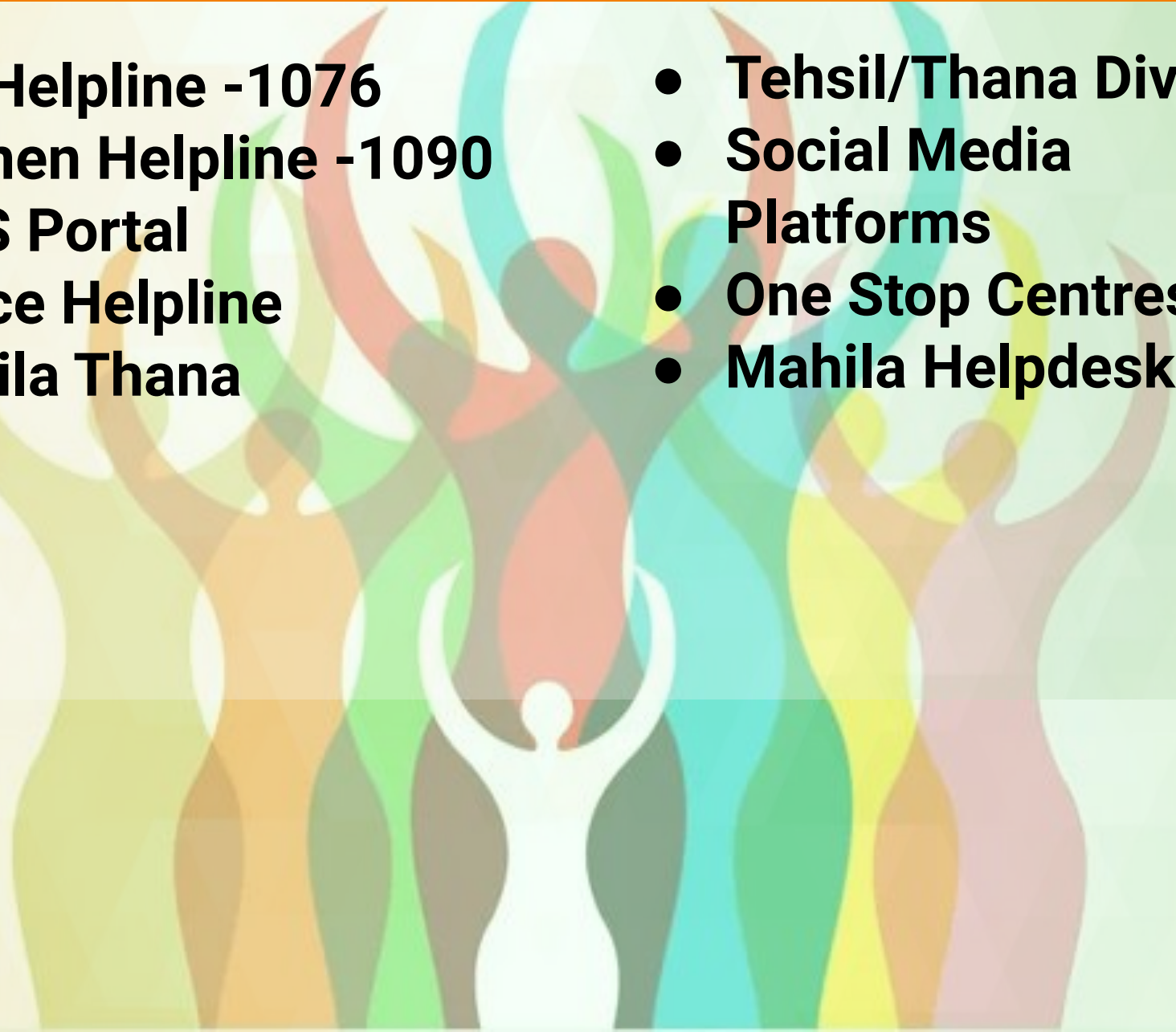


Major Challenges

- Low female literacy rate (52.62%)
- Lack of social awareness and skills
- Social and religious stigmas
- Limited sectors for women's involvement:
 - Agriculture, stitching, handicrafts, beautician, domestic work
- Marketing and quality issues in local products
- Limited participation in political, social, and economic activities
- Low representation in government offices
