Monthly Summary for the month of FEBRUARY 2018

The 21st National Conference on e-Governance was organized at Hyderabad on February 26-27, 2018. The theme of the Conference was "Technology for accelerating Development." Shri Kalvakuntla Tarka Rama Rao, Minister of IT, Municipal Administration & Urban Development, Industries & Commerce, Public Enterprises, Sugar, Mines & Geology and NRI Affairs, State Government of Telangana presided over the Conference in the inaugural session on 26.2.2018. During the two day conference, panel discussions were also organized on the following sub-themes:

- I. Building User Experience
- II. Universalization and Replication
- III. Governing e-Governance
- IV. E-Governance good/best practices
- V. Emerging Technologies.

In the valedictory session of the Conference on 27th February 2018, Dr. Jitendra Singh, Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Development of North-Eastern Region, MoS PMO, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Department of Atomic Energy and Department of Space presented the 19 National e-Governance Awards in 8 categories to champions of the initiatives, who had excelled in the field of e-governance during the year 2016-17.

The Department organized exposure visit for 15 officers of Government of India and the States/UTs including PM Award winners/National e- Governance winners to the Korea Development Institute (KDI), Seoul, South Korea during 19-23 February, 2018 for learning on "Citizen-Centric On-line Services through e-Governance with focus on Minimum Government and Maximum Governance".
