## Government of India Department of Administrative Reforms & Public Grievances

Major developments pertaining to Department of Administrative Reforms & Public Grievances during the month of JUNE, 2018 are listed below:

## 1. International exchange & cooperation.

- 1.1 Department is exploring the possibility of having MoUs with various foreign countries ranking high in the field of e-Governance especially in delivery of online citizen centric services.
- 1.2 In furtherance of this aim, Department has signed/renewed an MoU on 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2018 with the Public Service Division of the Republic of Singapore on 'Cooperation in the field of Personnel Management and Public Administration.
- 1.3 The main objective of the MoU is to strengthen and promote bilateral cooperation between the two countries in public administration and governance. The areas of co-operation under this MoU include Workforce, Workplace and Jobs, Public Service Delivery, Human Resource Management, Public Sector Reform, Leadership/Talent Development; and E-Governance/Digital Government.
- In the matter relating to monitoring implementation of e-Office in all central 2. Ministries / Departments in a time bound manner, I would like to inform you that as on date, 37 Central Ministries / Departments have moved to e-Office platform. Ministry of Corporate Affairs achieved 80% of e-file percentage recently. About 37 Central Ministries / Departments are showing improving trends. The Ministry of AYUSH is the most recent to go live on e-Office platform. The DAR&PG had also organized a meeting on 28.07.2018 on the subject of steps & security framework to be adopted in while dealing of classified documents/papers on the e-Office platform. In the meeting Secretary (MeiTY), Dr. Gulshan Rail-Chief Cyber Security-PMO, DG-NIC and Director (Security)-MHA were also present. A view had emerged that for the present we should keep the classified documents/papers out of e-Office platform. Simultaneously, we are required to review the departmental instructions relating to treatment of classified documents/papers and also need of setting up of a separate network/infrastructure of e-Office for dealing with classified documents/files in future.

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
