




Need

- No mechanism to identify individual learning needs to adopt targeted, innovative pedagogical practices
- No data at granular level; all existing review process are summary oriented
- Teachers were burdened with heavy paper work; inaccessible geographical area made data collection and distribution difficult
- Dantewada is a malaria endemic area with API > 56 (Normal is 4)
 - Health profile and growth chart of every child is essential
- Need for transparent functioning of schools to make them accountable to people
- Remedial education is as important as classwise achievement levels

Routine health check-ups initiated; data collection through PDLD mobile app

- To collect data related to learning and health outcomes
- Works also in offline mode as maximum number of schools are out of mobile network coverage
- Reports can also be seen from the app

- Earlier shiksha samitis usually used to discuss about physical infrastructure in schools – now discussion revolves around learning levels – readily available student wise data available with Gram Shiksha Samiti



Outcomes: Special focus on children with low HB levels

- Three extremely critical students identified and referred to higher centres
- Special diet charts implemented for students with poor and average Hb. levels











Outcomes: Growth in Hindi learning levels

- Initially only 20.9% students were able to read Hindi
- Now it is 50.6%
- Assessed by Pratham in their independent study*

Growth in Hindi Learning Levels








- Despite high growth rate, achievement is only 41.7%

Growth in Maths Learning Levels







- With pass percentage 84%, Dantewada has created a benchmark for other districts in 2016-17
- Earlier Dantewada used to be a continuously low performing district, since last two years has been consistently amongst top 5 districts in the state

Way Forward: Shifting from remedial classes to learning outcomes





- Focus was earlier on providing remedial education to slow learners
- From this academic year, focus is on acquiring age appropriate skill sets
- MHRD has prescribed class and subject appropriate skills from class 1 to class 8
- Student's performance is based on number of skills acquired/total number of skills
- SCERT has revised textbooks as per new LOs
- Annual academic and assessment calendars have been prepared for the district by core team of teachers



Way Forward: Community engagement

- Orientation of Sarpanches and PRI members towards focus on learning outcomes
- Separate login for members of SMC (Parent teacher association)
- They are to verify the data independently to avoid data forging by teachers
- Parent friendly school report card to facilitate monthly SMC meeting
- 4 palak balak sammelans to be held to involve parents in children's learning process
- Sense of inter-village competition to achieve better enrolment, attendance and learning outcomes



Way Forward: School accreditation

- Inspired by NAAC
- District Institute of Education Training (DIET) is district level accrediting agency
- Additional financial allocations has been made for monitoring
- Schools to be graded on:
 - Student's performance in learning outcomes (60%)
 - Student's attendance (20%)
 - Activeness of School Management Committee (10%)
 - Teacher attendance (10%)
- Accreditation process is completely transparent and automated
 - No human intervention
 - DIET is to verify the data collected




Way Forward: Financial incentives to schools, clust ers and GPs

Sustainability and Replicability



- Citizen charter has been issued across the district
- All details of students and progress reports can be downloaded from <u>www.padhedantewada.com</u>
- Maths/Hindi levels are being regularly monitored by NITI Aayog for 117 Aspirational Districts
- No additional resources required to sustain this project as Mobile app and portal are in place
- Teachers and education functionaries are to use this app – no additional human resources required
- Dantewada's mobile network coverage area is just 12%
 if we could do it here, it can be done everywhere
- To fulfil the aims of RTE 2009 we need to start focusing on students outcomes

Chhattisgarh's Maoist-affected Dantewada Latest overtakes urban counterparts with 80 per cent pass percentage

RAIPUR: abiting Dantewada, the worst Maoist-affected district in south Chhattisgarh, have made their presence felt in the high school poard examination results with the pass percentage crossing the 80 per cent mark for the first time. Chhattisgarh's overall pass

Dantewada, where left-wing extremists had demolished a maximum number of schools during the last decade and a half, has improved its previous year's result of 64 per cent.

The district with 80.70 pass percentage emerged as the best performing district in the board exam. Girls performed marginally better than boys with their pass percentage at 81.57 and 79.83
