





robust monitoring mechanisms resulted in:

- Successful conduct of massive interdepartmental coordination (state & center),
- All permanent infra works being completed well within time, and
- Saving of 15% of the sanctioned project costs; never heard of before!

- Strengthening and widening of 264 roads in the city and those leading up to the mela area
- Redesigning, refurbishing and beautification work of 64 traffic junctions
- 9 ROBs constructed and 6 RUBs widened within 18 months
- New airport terminal built spread across 6400 sq. m.
- Infrastructure upgradation for police stations, public health, tourism, railways, electricity, and water supply
- Paint My City Campaign; more than 17 Lakh sq. ft. of street art work executed

~64% of expenditure was on permanent infrastructure improvement; leaving a lasting, positive legacy in Prayagraj
































World's Largest Temporary City; set up in just 2 months



Kumbh Mela area was saturated with infrastructure and amenities for pilgrim experience enhancement:

- ~500 Km of temporary roads and 22 pontoon bridges
- ~47,000 LED lights, 1,180 Km LT lines, and 2.8 Lakh Camp connections with MCBs
- 8 Km of ghats were developed with changing rooms for female pilgrims
- 150 Km HDPE pipeline and 850 Km Drains
- 24X7 drinking water supply and Water ATMs
- Saturated with civil supplies, grocery shops, vending zones, milk booths, hotels, public accommodation etc.


Kumbh 2019 was hosted in the world's largest temporary city, which rivalled some of the biggest permanent cities in scale, grandeur, and access to civic amenities



Swachh Kumbh; innovation in toilet design and operations



- More than 1,14,755 toilets installed in 2 months
- >20,000 dustbins with liner bags, 120 tippers and 40 compactors deployed for solid waste management
- ICT-based system deployed to monitor and ensure timely cleaning of toilets
- Proper onsite sludge management, cesspool operations and odour free Mela
- 7800+ sanitation workers employed and 1500+ Swacchagrahis engaged
- Dignified living conditions for all sanitation workers and digital/Aadhar-based payments
- Use of permanent and temporary STPs, bioremediation etc. for clean Ganga

First-ever open defecation free, garbage free, and odour free Kumbh due to use of technology and focus on behavior change






Regular cleaning of toilets done to ensure ODF Mela





- Project implemented in just 5 months
- 2 Command and Control Centres one in Mela area and one in city
- 1000+ cameras installed for 24x7 surveillance
- Use of Artificial Intelligence for crowd management
- Unified helpline number, 1920, for all grievances, command and control, and disaster management
- 4 Viewing Centres and 40+ VMD
- Financial convergence with Smart City Project







Secure Kumbh

- More than 50,000 police personnel and 8,000 volunteers were deployed to execute an in-depth three-tier security plan
- 1,378 fire officers and 1500 fire extinguishers were deployed. 63 high pressure mist bikes used for the first time
- Several innovations in water-safety were achieved; 10K life jackets distributed, rescue scooters and boats, river ambulance, 3Km reflective river line
- Coordinated disaster management planning with NDMA and SDMA. Application of Incident Response System (IRS)
- Seamless coordination with Army, Air Force, ATS, STF, NDRF, SDRF, GRP, IB, NSG and Home Guards etc.

Comprehensive planning & usage of modern equipment led to the first-ever incident-free Kumbh in 200 years









Transportation Planning and Crowd Management



- Zone-wise traffic planning with different strategies for peak and non-peak days
- 90 fenced parking lots, spread over 1300 Ha complete with basic amenities were created with capacity to hold 3 lakh vehicles
- 500+ Shuttle buses were deployed, on which 63 lakh passenger trips occurred. E-rickshaws were deployed
- 1500+ signages were installed, ensuring effective path finding for pilgrims
- 12 Contingency plans for movement and traffic diversion were prepared

Guiding principles for mobility planning;

- Ensure pilgrims don't have to walk more than 5 Kms,
- Flush out vehicles 2-days before peak,
- Maintain no-vehicle zone for 2 days,
- Utilize holding areas to the max,



- Computerized Mela city planning and land allotment system, leading to zero disputes, no traffic jams, clean Kumbh, and legacy management
- 15 fully-digitized lost and found centers were established



- Vaicharik Kumbh; intellectual conclave on socially relevant topics was held
- 8,000 Kumbh Sewa Mitras and Police Mitras were deployed in Ghat Management, Events, Lost and Found, Toilets Monitoring etc.
