

Visit of Dr. Jitendra Singh, MOS(PP) in the Department of Administrative Reforms & Public Grievances on 29th May, 2018 during Swachhta Pakhwada from 16th May to 31st May, 2018

Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) Development of North-Eastern Region (DoNER), MoS PMO, Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions, Atomic Energy and Space, Dr Jitendra Singh will visit the office premises of the Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances at Sardar Patel Bhawan on May 29, 2018 to see the implementation of the Swachhata Action Plan.
