


Challenges remain: 5 Proactive measures by States needed.

- Convergence at block level health, Swachhta and nutrition needs improvement.
- State Prabhari officers network need further activation.
- Vacancies in Health, education and Agriculture extension worker, especially at block level need to be filled up.
- Using Aspirational district template, ranking and rewarding of block level functionaries.
- Posting dynamic collectors with 3 year tenure



DFS: New Deployment of Banking outlets, where remaining, within 5 km distance of inhabited villages



District wise details shared with States + DMs. They are to provide list of Post Offices where Postal banking to be prioritised.



Initiatives Required: Strengthening of District level Implementation Committee (DLIC)

- DFS has nominated an ED/CGM level officer for each district.
- DMs should take advantage of this arrangement.

It is reported that in many districts regular meeting of DLIC is not taking place.








Specific Role of States: Activate State Prabhari officers

Role of State Prabhari officers in ensuring requisite action by State is critical.



Challenges remain: divergence between survey data and reported data

- Nit Aayog has received survey data on 40+ indicators from Tata trusts (85 districts), ID Insight- Gates foundation (27 Districts)
- We are analysing this data. Drawing confidence intervals to ensure that there is no major variations.
- Still, there are significant variations.
- We shall share this with Districts shortly.
- We are also computing data for fresh ranking.

Ideally, as we go along, variations should become negligible. DMs are requested to check the validity of data they are uploading.



Example of Hazaribagh

- Used template of Aspirational District programme ranked blocks.
- Rewarded block level officers who have done well.
- Generated enthusiasm in public as well as officers.
- Governing Council of Niti Aayog recommended identification of 20% of blocks.
