Multi Modal Terminal (NW-1)

Begusarai, with 31 MMT cargo in 2024, is poised to emerge as Eastern India's premier logistics hub through a state-of-the-art Multi-Modal Terminal.

The proposed terminal will help in enhancing cargo movement, reduce logistics cost, promote green transport, boost local economy and employment.
